

## Procedures for Requesting Removal of Defamatory or Infringing Material

These procedures are incorporated into and are part of the Terms and Conditions Agreement of the Orthopedic One website (Site). The owner of a copyrighted work (or the agent for the owner) who believes that material posted on the Site infringes on the copyrighted work may request that the allegedly infringing material be removed from the Site by notifying Orthopedic One. The notice of alleged copyright infringement must:

- a) identify in sufficient detail the copyrighted work claimed to have been infringed;
- c) include a statement by the copyright owner or authorized agent that he or she has a good faith belief that the disputed use is unauthorized and include electronic or physical signature of the owner or agent;
- d) include a statement that the information contained in the request is accurate and an attestation, under penalty of perjury, that the requesting party is the copyright owner or authorized agent; and
- f) include the copyright owner's or authorized agent's name, mailing address, telephone number, and email address.

A notice of alleged copyright infringement may be submitted to Orthopedic One's designated copyright agent by mail or email as set forth below:
